What are cookies and why are they necessary?

Cookies are small text documents created by websites you visit and stored on your computer. They are widely used to ensure the functioning of websites and transmit important information to website owners. Most web resources utilize cookies to improve the efficiency of their sites.

How to configure cookies on your device?

We use cookies to personalize content and enhance your experience of using our website. By continuing to use the site, you agree to the use of cookies. You can manage cookies through your browser settings (details below). Please note that deleting or blocking cookies may affect the functionality of the website and render certain components inaccessible.

How to remove cookies?

Most programs provide options to manage cookies, including deleting and blocking them. However, keep in mind that deleting all cookies will require you to reconfigure preferences on each site, including the option to opt out of tracking, as this function requires additional setup that needs to be re-entered.

What data is stored on the Open Finance website?

We store the following data:

1. **Essential Data:** This data is necessary for the functioning of the website. It includes information that allows you to access secured sections of the site and utilize its core features.
2. **Analytical/Administrative Data:** This data provides information on the usage of the Open Finance website, such as when and how often it is accessed, the existence of customer groups, and the search engines used. It is also possible to obtain data from third parties.
3. **Targeted Data:** This data remembers your visits to our website, the pages you viewed, and the links you clicked on. We use this data to enhance the usability of our site and tailor it to your preferences.
